Scheduling

- It is the discretion of the PURCHASER to begin or delay the scheduled performance at an earlier or later starting time with the consent of the ARTISTS. However, the ARTISTS will not be required to perform beyond the number of total minutes ordinarily contracted for, or past the predetermined time of completion, but may do so should ARTISTS desire.

Insurance

- PURCHASER is responsible for all insurance of the venue and its guests as well as ARTISTS. PURCHASER agrees to indemnify ARTISTS in conjunction with any occurrence directly associated with the Performance against the PURCHASER or related to independent contractors.

Security

- PURCHASER is responsible for all security which may be required for the venue, including any and all security that ARTISTS may require. This includes, but is not limited to security for personnel, vehicles, equipment and ARTISTS' prior to, during and after the Performance. PURCHASER must demonstrate ability to provide the afore mentioned or is grounds for termination of this Agreement

Environment

- No Televisions, Radios, CD players, Video Games, Arcade Games or Juke Boxes within 50 feet of the performance may be engaged or in use during the performance. No restaurant style bussing stations, bar stations, food stations or computer terminals within 50 feet of the performance will be used or accessible during the performance.

All succeeding items will be strictly adhered to, except those noted as Not Applicable (N.A.) by mutual consent of ARTIST & PURCHASER

Electrical _____

- PURCHASER must provide power within 25 feet of performance area 110 Volt with no less than 15 amp circuits.

Staging _____

- A minimum stage size of 24 feet by 16 feet is required. Stage floorings to be level, smooth, carpeted and skirted. 2 safety stairs located stage left & right or at rear of stage. Rain/ Weather covering must be provided for outside performances.

Sales _____

- PURCHASER will permit ARTISTS to sell and/or distribute promotional materials on premises. All associated sales and taxes will be handled directly by the ARTISTS. No percentage of gross sales will be made to PURCHASER.

Dressing Facility (ies) _____

- Artists require secured, well lit room with mirrors chairs and/or couches, with warm & cold running water, and bathroom. Room will accommodate 6-8 people.

Promotions _____

- PURCHASER agrees to advertise and promote the ARTISTS' performance in a timely fashion, (minimum two weeks prior to Performance) through applicable methods (i.e. Radio, T.V., Postering, Banners, Flyers, Table Cards, Newspapers, Ads, Email, etc

Lighting _____

- All lighting provided by PURCHASER
 2 Lighting Trees left & right side of stage no less than 4 cans each or proscenium lighting frame with no less than 8 cans
